

# The Great Thanksgiving in Honor of Black History Month

- L: The Lord be with you.
- P: And also with you.
- L: Lift up your hearts.
- P: We lift them up to the Lord.
- L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- P: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

L: It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, almighty God, creator of heaven and earth. You formed us in your image and breathed into us the breath of life. When human cruelty reared its ugly head, you sustained your people and made it possible for your precious children to survive the middle passage, auction blocks, whipping posts and forced labor. You softened the hearts of many who worked in secret on their behalf. You lifted our heads with the message that God sides with the oppressed and delivers the captives. You strengthened your people's hands to struggle for justice and freedom. And so, with your people on earth and all the company of heaven we praise your name and join their unending hymn:



## **Liturgy for the Sacrament of Holy Communion (continued)**

L: Holy are you, and blessed is your Son Jesus Christ, who left the comforts of glory to live among a people estranged from God. By his life and example, he taught us that it was possible to love our neighbors and live together as family. By the baptism of his suffering, death, and resurrection you gave birth to your Church, delivered us from slavery to sin and death, and made with us a new covenant by water and the Spirit.

L: On the night in which he gave himself up for us, Jesus took bread, gave thanks to you, broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said: "Take, eat: this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." When the supper was over, he took the cup, gave thanks to you, and gave it to his disciples, and said: "Drink from this, all of you; this cup is the new covenant in my blood, poured out for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

L: And so, in remembrance of these your mighty acts in Jesus Christ, we offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in union with Christ's offering for us, as we proclaim the mystery of faith.

## People: Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here, and on these gifts of bread and wine. Make them be for us the body and blood of Christ, that we may be for the world the body of Christ, redeemed by his blood. Renew our communion with your Church throughout the world, and strengthen it in every nation and among every people to witness faithfully in your name. By your Spirit make us one with Christ, one with each other, and one in ministry to all the world, until Christ comes in final victory, and we feast at his heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church, all honor and glory is yours, now and forever.
